

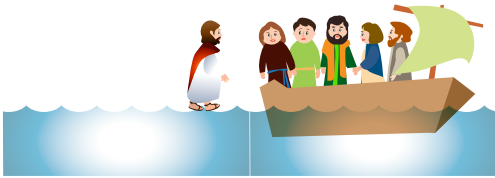
The Water Walker

Suddenly, Peter saw that the wind was blowing hard, and he began to get afraid. He started to sink, and Jesus came and pulled him into the boat.



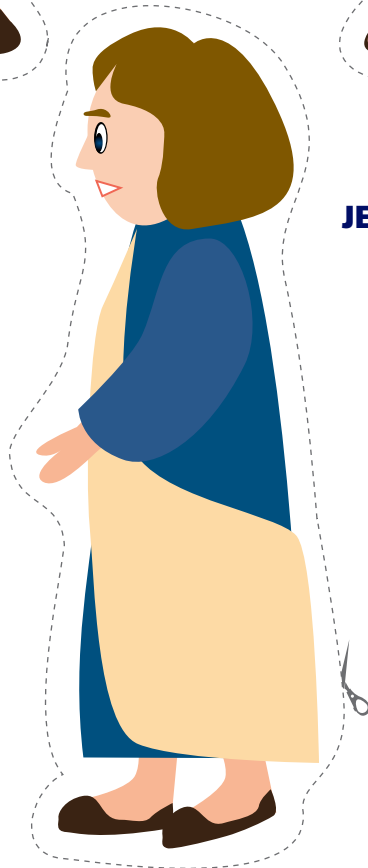
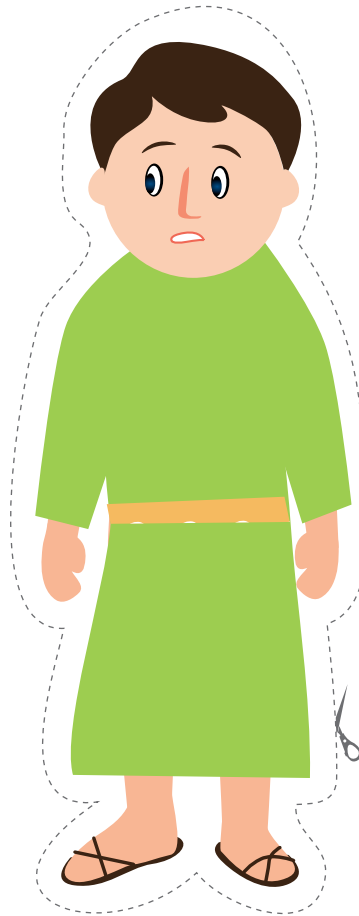
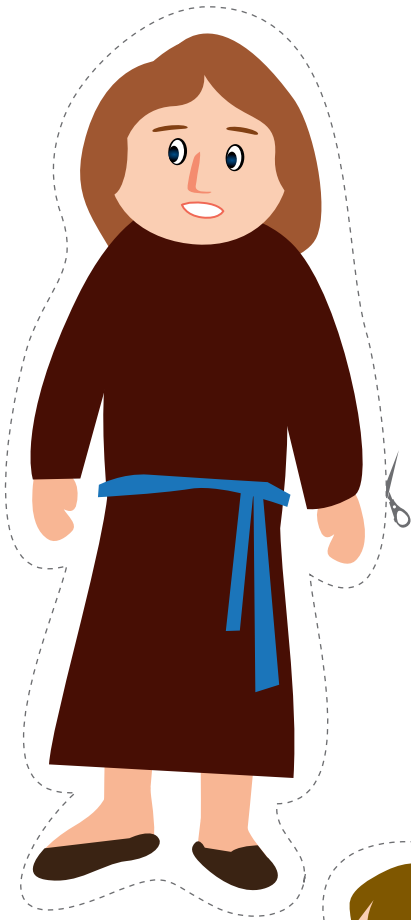

Peter was amazed at the power Jesus had. He said, **"Lord, surely, you are the Son of God."**

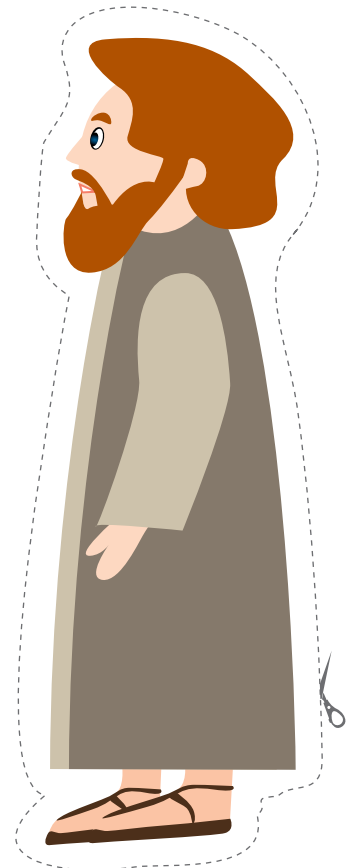


Finally, they came to the other side of the lake. The people recognized Jesus, and brought out their sick for Jesus to heal them.
